THE FUSION OF ART AND DESIGN comes to life at the Haughton International Art + Design Fair, taking place October 3 through 8 at The Park Avenue Armory in New York. Exemplary 20th-century and contemporary furniture, ceramics, metalwork, paintings, textiles, and more are offered to connoisseurs, collectors, curators, decorators, and members of the visiting public. The fair is a platform for some of the hottest national and international galleries, many of them at the forefront of the "design as art" movement. Highlights of the 2007 fair included a masterpiece of Art Deco furniture by Joubert et Petit (DIM), a 1924 cabinet in macassar ebony and ivory with original porteur marble top, which sold for \$125,000; a 1968 sofa-and-chair set (\$18,000) by Pierre Paulin; and a Paulin table with an interior light in white opaque and smoked glass plexiglass, designed for George Pompidou's private apartments in Paris. All items for sale have been strictly vetted for authenticity and quality by teams of specialists, giving an important measure of consumer protection to prospective buyers.
